

Iceland – The Land of Fire & Ice

Detailed Itinerary

Monday, September 25, 2017

Your adventure to Iceland begins with an evening flight to Reykjavik originating in Windsor, Canada.

Tuesday, September 26, 2017

Arrive in Reykjavik in the morning. Transfer to your hotel, the beautiful new Canopy by Hilton Reykjavik Hotel in the heart of the city centre. (transfers not included). Spend the afternoon exploring the city center on your own. In the early evening, join a welcome reception at the hotel lounge where you will have a chance to get to know your fellow travelers and review our exciting itinerary.

Wednesday, September 27, 2017

After breakfast, depart for a city tour where you will be taken to all of the city's major attractions, including: the old town centre, the Parliament, the cathedral, the harbour, the National Museum, Laugadalur swimming pool, the Ásmundur Sveinsson Sculpture museum, the Pearl, Höfði house (site of the 1986 summit) and the city's main landmark, Hallgrímskirkja.

Thursday, September 28, 2017

Spend the day at leisure exploring some of Reykjavik's natural wonders or take the optional full day tour of the Golden Circle. Combining natural and historical wonders, you'll experience Iceland's landmark attractions in one incredible day: the magnificent Gullfoss waterfall, the spouting hot springs of Geysir, and Þingvellir national park, site of the Viking parliament and over 1000 years of history.

In the evening, we take a tour in search for the Northern Lights, also known as the Aurora Borealis, a miraculous natural phenomenon that lights up the Icelandic Arctic sky with brilliant colors that is simply breathtaking.

*Please note: This tour is subject to correct weather conditions and the Aurora Borealis cannot be guaranteed. If the tour is cancelled, another Northern Lights tour will be offered on a different night while in Reykjavik.

Friday, September 29, 2017

After breakfast depart for the world-famous Blue Lagoon, a unique wonder of nature; a lake where you will relax and escape the stress of your daily life with pleasantly warm mineral-rich geothermal water in the middle of a black lava field. The high natural levels of silica and minerals give the Lagoon its rich blue color. The facilities include modern changing rooms and showers, an indoor geothermal pool, a winter garden, restaurants and other services.

Saturday, September 30, 2017

Spend the final day in Reykjavik shopping for world renowned woolens or other popular souvenirs, exploring the town on your own, or taking one of optional tours available such as horseback riding or whale watching.

Sunday, October 1, 2017

Check out of the hotel and transfer to the airport for your return flight home. (transfers not included).
