Precautionary Measures for The Kentucky Derby Weekend

While your safety is always a priority for us, we have implemented some new health and safety procedures in response to the current state of the country as of June 2020. Please note these health and safety protocols may change as the Coronavirus (COVID-19) situation changes.

Our bus that will be used throughout the tour will undergo an extensive cleaning and sanitizing at the beginning and end of each day by the driver.

*We have contracted with Getaway Tours for a full-size bus (56 passengers) rather than the 38 passenger bus that we have used in past tours. We will limit our tour size to 26 passengers. This will enable us to have 2 empty seats between each passenger and an aisle. (I passenger will be seated on each side of the aisle per row).

The coach that will be used throughout the tour will undergo an extensive cleaning and sanitizing at the beginning and end of each day by the driver.

Per the recommendations by local and federal government agencies, including Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) guidelines, we will require all passengers to wear a face mask while on the bus.

All passengers will be encouraged to practice social distancing while in a large group of people.

Passengers will be asked to divulge pre-existing health conditions on our Release and Waiver form.

Passengers will be asked to reveal if they have traveled internationally in the past 30 days.

We will ask passengers that have been sick or feel sick within the 14 days prior to the departure, to stay at home. Refunds 30 days prior to departure or less will be under the terms and conditions of the travel insurance policy.

As always, we are recommending passengers purchase travel protection insurance so if they are unable to travel due to a sickness, they will be eligible for a refund based on the terms and conditions of the travel insurance company.

We will have an alcohol-based hand sanitizer available for use upon entering and exiting the motorcoach.

We will continue to closely monitor health and safety concerns in regards to the Coronavirus (COVID-19) and follow the recommendations by local and federal government agencies, including Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
