Day 1 & 2 March 5 & 6, 2019

Depart for our international flight. Cross the international date time and lose one day.

Day 3 March 7, 2019

Arrive in Singapore and transfer to the hotel, the Ibis Hotel On Bencoolen. (Airport transfers not included). This Singapore hotel offers a prime location, just a 2-minute walk from Bugis Junction's shops and food markets. A bus stop is right outside the door and an MRT station is within a 10-minute walk. We start our day in Singapore with a splashing fun time on the unique DUCK city and harbor tour. This hour-long journey brings you up close to Singapore's famous skyline, historical landmarks and gorgeous bay view. The very first amphibious themed attraction in Asia, this award-winning DUCK is rated Number 1 in Singapore with 1 million passengers and 14 years of perfect safety record. More than a tour, it's 60 minutes of full-on thrill where you go on a voyage to discover the past, present and the future. Hear the captivating Singapore story from the well-loved DUCKtainers commentating onboard the craft while you capture snapshots of the city's major monuments.

After lunch on your own, enjoy the remainder of the day at leisure. Perhaps explore the festive Chinatown or Little India. In the evening, meet for a delicious Welcome Dinner with your fellow passengers.

Day 4 & 5 March 8 & 9, 2019

Day 7 March 11, 2019

First author Elizabeth Gilbert found love and inspiration in Bali when writing her book Eat, Pray, Love. Then,

actress Julia Roberts followed in her footsteps in the book's big screen adaptation. We head out with our private guide to see filming locations from the beloved film and heartwarming memoir.

The first stop is the Elephant Cave, Goa Gajah. It's name is slightly misleading, lending the impression that it's a gigantic dwelling full of elephants. Rather, it's an archaeological site of significant historical value, with a stunning relic-filled courtyard, rock-wall carvings, a central meditational cave, bathing pools and fountains.

Next we tour the Ubud Sacred Monkey Forest. The village's residents view the Monkey Forest as an important spiritual, economic, educational, and conservation center for the village. There are many of points of interest that you can see here. Other than around 700 monkeys, you also can see 186 species of trees in 12.5 hectares of forest.

The next stop is at Cafe Wayan, a breezy outdoor eatery where we can snag a seat at the table where Julia Roberts dined. Enjoy a delicious rijsttafel, a Dutch word that literally translates to "rice table", an elaborate meal adapted by the Dutch. You'll have a chance to sample an impressive assortment of traditional Balinese specialties.

After lunch we'll have a chance to view the elaborate 16th-century Ubud Royal Palace from the outside.

Our final stop of the day is at the Ubud Arts and Crafts Market. In this shoppers' paradise, you'll find hundreds of stalls bursting with wood carvings, batik shirts, sarongs, jewelry, trinkets, and all manners of souvenirs aimed specifically at visitors to the area. Evening is at leisure.

Then we visit the Tegalalang Rice Terrace, verdant steps of rice paddies dotted with feathery palm trees. Then enjoy a delicious included dinner at one of the popular seafood restaurants on the beach near the temple.
