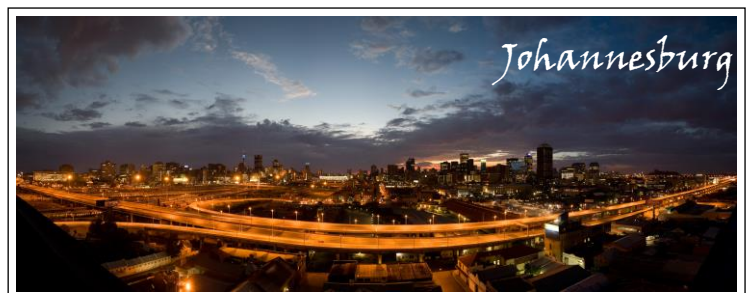

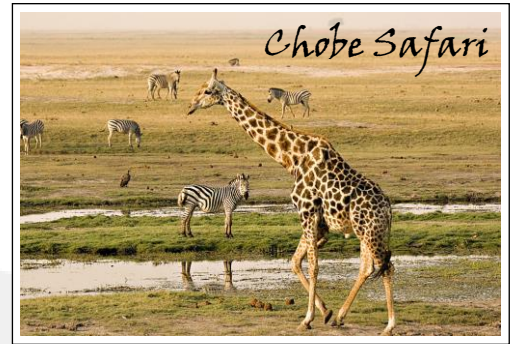

Victoria Falls

Today we will transfer overland from Botswana (Chobe) to Victoria Falls in Zimbabwe. Once we have checked into our hotel we will then do the tour of the falls in the late afternoon.

Discovered by Livingstone in 1855 (known to the local people as “Mosi o Tunya” the smoke that thunders), the numerous viewpoints count among the most exceptional on the planet. A show that justifies crossing the Atlantic for.

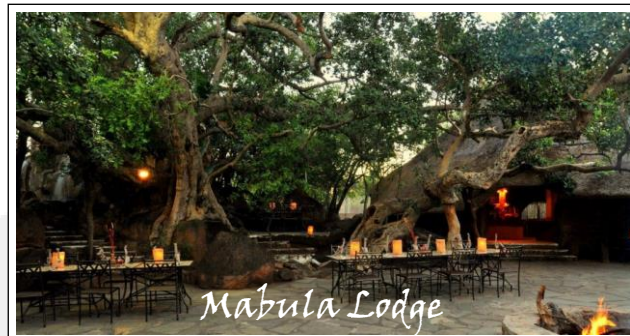

You will have enough time in the morning to take a last chance flight over the falls by helicopter, known as “the flight of angels” due to a remark Dr David Livingstone made in his diary “Falls so beautiful that angels must have surely wept in flight as they flew over them”.

On arrival in Johannesburg you will be met by your luxury coach which will transfer you to your private game reserve approximately 2,5 hours drive north west of Johannesburg.

You will depart on a late afternoon early evening game drive on arrival.

Mabula Lodge Game Reserve

The beautiful, rustic Mabula Game Reserve is a private game reserve which is located about two hours’ drive from Johannesburg in the Waterberg region of the Limpopo Province. It has an area of about 12,000 hectares (30,000 acres).

It boasts numerous mammals, birds, plants, reptiles and insects. Wildlife includes the “big five” (lion, leopard, buffalo, African elephant and rhinoceros); but also the small five (ant lion, leopard tortoise, buffalo weaver, elephant shrew and rhino beetle).

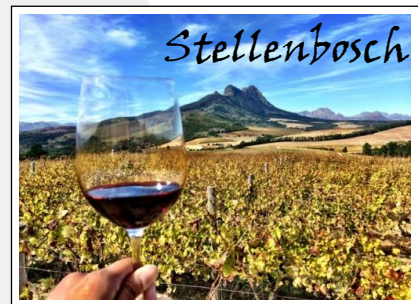

Chapman's Peak Drive

Drive along Cape Town's most scenic road: Chapman's Peak Drive. Hacked out of the face of the mountain between 1915 and 1922, Chapman's Peak connects Hout Bay with Noordhoek along one of the most dramatic marine routes in the world that hugs the coast of the Atlantic Seaboard for nine kilometres. Reopened to the public in 2003 after major safety works were completed, Chapman's Peak Drive climbs steadily from the harbour of Hout Bay, skirting 114 curves to follow the rocky coastline presenting some truly magnificent views of the sandy bays below. The combination of steep, almost thrilling rocky inclines, shimmering blue waters and expansive skies simply take the breath away.

Penguin Colony

Visit the jackass penguins at Boulder's Beach. This small piece of the coastline has become a haven for these birds and is one of the few remaining places where they are still able to roost without threat from human interference. Here you will be able to view these birds up close whilst not interfering with their natural habitat.

Visit the Cape of Good Hope Nature reserve. It is recognized globally for its extraordinary land formation, rich and diverse fauna and unique flora. The legendary Cape Point and Cape of Good Hope, were key beacons for the early explorers and are the source of many myths and legends.

In 1488, Bartholomew Dias named the Peninsula the Cape of Storms. King John II of Portugal later gave it its actual name. The Cape of Good Hope is a scenic wonder, where soft white sandy beaches alternate with rugged stretches of rock and breath taking cliffs. The mingling of the icy Atlantic Ocean with the warmer Indian Ocean results in a unique coastal environment and one of the most productive marine zones worldwide.
