After the civic neighborhood, appreciate an imposing panoramic view of Santiago from San Cristobal Hill which we will reach by a funicular or cable car, and enjoy the stunning mountain scenery that surrounds the capital.

Then have an opportunity to visit Pueblito Los Dominicos, a delightful artisan village. It's a must-visit for anyone seeking authentic Chilean crafts and a taste of the country's rich cultural heritage. You can shop for a variety of handmade items, including ceramics, textiles, jewelry, wood carvings, and more. Saturday, March 8, 2025 - Sunrise Tour to Tongariki & Terevaka Hike

You will depart very early from your hotel, heading towards the southeast coast of the island. Here, you will see the sunrise at Ahu Tongariki, the most majestic ceremonial platform in all of Rapa Nui, with its 15 moais. It is a very unique, magical and unforgettable experience!

Then, hike up the slopes of the Maunga Terevaka volcano until you reach its summit, the highest point on the island, at about 1676 feet. You'll witness a surprising natural spectacle, with a 360° panoramic view of the island and its volcanoes. This possibility of being able to see the entire island of Rapa Nui. surrounded only by sea, is amazing! This adventure will thrill you with beautiful landscapes, fresh air and living nature!

Sunday, March 9, 2025 - Free Day in Easter Island & Sunset Tour at Tahai



Spend the morning and afternoon at your leisure on the Island, where you can stay relax or perhaps arrange a visit on your own to one of the sites of the island not visited such as the beautiful Anakena beach.

In the evening, leave the hotel 1 ½ hours before sunset and drive to the ceremonial complex of Ahu Tahai. This place is renowned for being an important archaeological site of the island and was

restored in 1974. It is comprised of three ahu: Ko Te Riku (with repaired eyes), Tahai (with an eroded moai), and Vai Uri (with 5 moais). Here you will enjoy a breathtaking sunset with these beautiful

colorful architecture. Enjoy views of the city and its surrounding hills from the famous lookout of Mirador 21 de Mayo. Next, we go to Prat Dock where the city's sea trade heritage still flourishes. You'll have a chance to ride the funicular there for more magnificent views.

Then, drive to the lovely coastal town of Viña del Mar to enjoy an included lunch and a relaxing stroll down the streets and picturesque beaches before transferring to your hotel where the remainder of the

The legend behind Casillero del Diablo:

It all began years ago in Bordeaux, France. A ship set sail from Europe to South America, bringing along seeds of sacred vines. The ship landed in Chile and the small seeds were planted, growing vines of fresh, juicy grapes. The grapes were turned into delicious wine that was produced in a small cellar on the Concha y Toro property.

The cellar was always locked, yet somehow the wine frequently went missing. Don Melchor de Concha y Toro, Chilean businessman and vineyard owner, grew tired of his favorite wines disappearing. Legend says he spread a rumor that the devil himself was living deep within the Concha y Toro cellar. People from all over town heard the story. Many claimed it was true and said that they had witnessed the devil in the Concha y Toro cellar. Today, the legend lives on. Nobody knows if the story was true or if it was just a silly fib used to scare off the robbers. It's one tale that will forever remain a mystery...

For years, the legend of Casillero del Diablo has been told to visitors who come to the Concha y Toro winery, home to one of Chile's most popular and delicious wines, which to no surprise is named "Casillero del Diablo." This vineyard remains one of the most intriguing spots in Chile to enjoy a glass of wine and is visited daily by people from all over the world.
